Garden Gala was the matriarch of the horse farm where I worked. This is the mother of all my horse hair jewelry, the first style I created.

The flat braid is crafted from 12 horse hair pulls. Choose from three sterling silver closures. **Beads can be added to the braid for an additional \$15.**

- A. Sterling silver hook & loop closure. **\$46**
- B. Sterling silver lobster closure. **\$53**
- C. Sterling silver rectangular closure. **\$61**



{ Maxatawny }

Granddaughter of Garden Gala, Maxatawny was another favorite and mother of many on the farm. This bracelet combines my favorite wares: sterling silver, leather and horse hair.



The 12-strand horse hair braid and sterling silver wire roll around Greek leather (available in many colors).

Wear the leather side out for a rustic look or wear the horse hair side out in a refined style. Leather knot slides through loop for closure. **\$76**



{ Rapitorial }

Shiny and black. That defined Rapitorial, a gorgeous mare from Florida. She taught me a lot about securely closing gates.

It seems only appropriate her namesake has a shiny, stainless steel ID plaque and very secure push-button clasp. The front and back of the plaque are engraveable in the fonts at right.

The price of the bracelet includes up to 5 words engraved on the nameplate. Additional words cost \$4 each. Unlimited words. **\$95**

Horse Hair Jewelry Care

Remove horse hair jewelry before swimming or showering. Occasionally a piece of horse hair will work its way out of the braid. Use a nail clipper to trim it off close to the braid. **DO NOT** use a scissors as you may accidentally snip through the bracelet.

Most styles available with 14kt or 18kt gold, as well. Prices vary depending on gold market. Contact me for prices.

{ Leap Year }



A giant of a horse, Leap Year was the first real horse my daughter rode that

wasn't a \$5 pony ride at the fair. Only 2 years old at the time, my daughter looked tiny upon Leap Year's back, but her smile was enormous. My daughter still talks about that horse and wants to go back to ride him again.

The Leap Year bracelet is a round braid of horse hair, plaited around a leather core with sterling silver lobster clasp. **\$64**

{ Daisy }

These earrings are named after a sweet little paint named Daisy. She was a little bit of brown and a little bit of white.



These earrings are a bit of this and that, too: a bit of glossy horse hair, a touch of shiny sterling and a dash of gemstone.

Pick a gemstone to dangle in the horse hair loop: chalcedony (shown), turquoise,

amethyst, garnet, citrine or peridot. Or send me your favorite pair of beads to include. Choose from fishhook ear wires (shown) or lever back earrings. **\$61**

Collecting Horse Hair

Cut a minimum of **14 inches for a bracelet** and a minimum of **10 inches for earrings**, although longer is better. **Cut several small locks** from the underside of the tail to make a clump of hair about the width of your finger. Secure horse hair with a rubber band and place it in a bag. I will clean the hair before braiding. Mane hair can be used, but due to the extra work involved in braiding, will incur an additional \$20 fee.

Sizing

Wrap a seamstress measuring tape or piece of string around your wrist to measure your actual wrist size. Then hold the tape measure around your wrist as loose as you'd like the bracelet and record that size, as well.

Average women's bracelet: 7" – 7 1/4"

Average men's bracelet: 8 1/2" – 8 3/4"

Shipping

All products will be shipped USPS Priority Mail with insurance and a \$7.50 shipping charge will be added to each order. Fed Ex or UPS can be requested; additional shipping charges will apply.
